### Freshman Admission Requirements

Students who meet the minimum graduation requirements of their high school and one of the following criteria will be admitted to NMSU:

**Cumulative high school GPA of 2.75** 

OR

**ACT composite score of 21** 

OR

SAT score of 1060

When you're ready to apply, all we need is your self-reported, weighted cumulative high school GPA. Most students receive a decision within 2-3 business days!

#### **Aggie Pathway**

If you are not initially offered admission to the NMSU Las Cruces campus, our Aggie Pathway Program can navigate you toward a bachelor's degree. 





### **Quick Lane Bowl Champions**

The Aggies brought home a bowl victory during the 2022-2023 season with a dramatic 24-19 victory against the Bowling Green Falcons. The Aggies made their first Quick Lane Bowl game appearance Dec. 26, 2022, at Ford Field in Detroit, Michigan. It was the first career bowl game win for NMSU Football Head Coach Jerry Kill bringing the Aggies' overall bowl game record to four wins, no losses and one tie. Quarterback Diego Pavia was named Quick Lane Bowl's most valuable player after passing for 167 yards and rushing for 65 yards.








