Freshman Admission Requirements

Students who meet the minimum graduation requirements of their high school and one of the following criteria will be admitted to NMSU:

Cumulative high school GPA of 2.75

OR

SAT score of 1060

OR

ACT score of 21

When you're ready to apply, all we need is your self-reported, weighted cumulative high school GPA. Most students receive a decision within 1-2 business days!

Aggie Pathway

If you are not initially offered admission to the NMSU Las Cruces campus, our Aggie Pathway Program will navigate you toward a bachelor's degree. Aggie Pathway students transition to the Las Cruces campus after successful completion of 24 credits and a 2.0 cumulative college GPA. aggiepathway.nmsu.edu














FAMILY ENGAGEMENT
